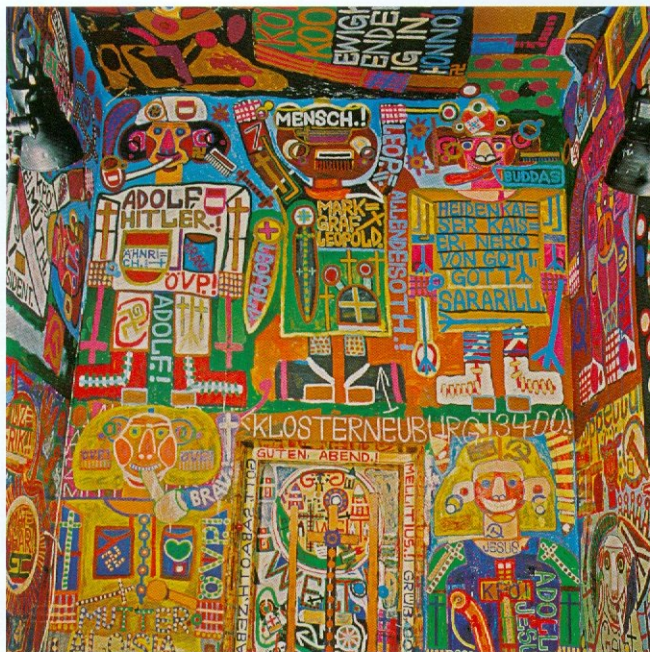


## WALLA! CONTINUES AT GUGGING

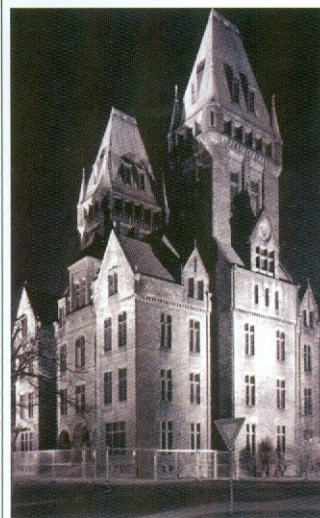

## NEW ZEALAND OUTSIDERS

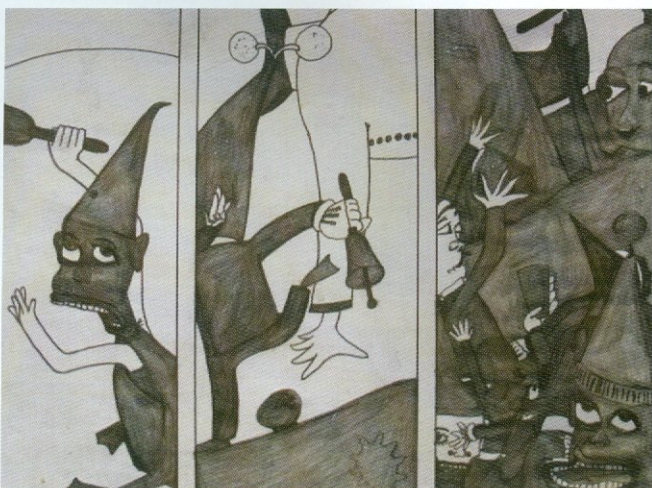

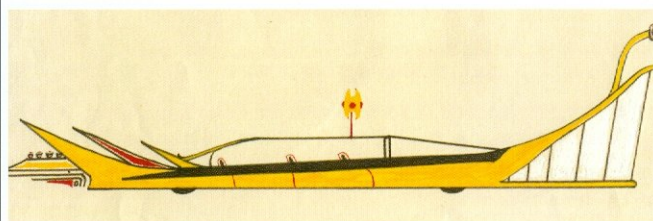
